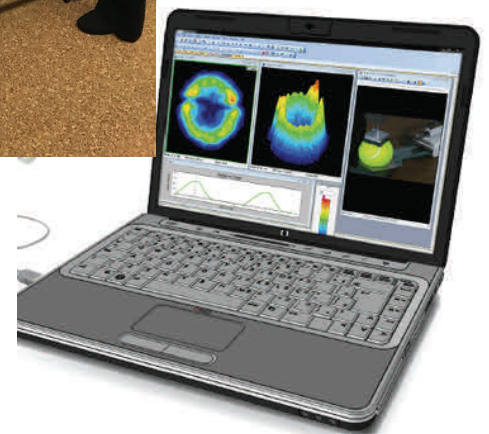
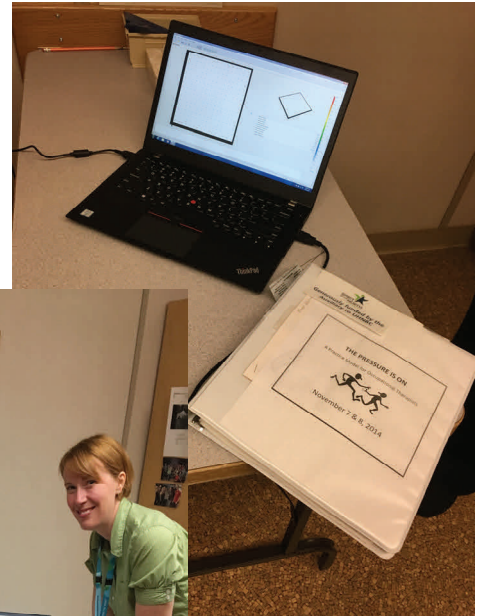

As people age, become limited in their capacity, or are sedentary, their body can have natural pressure points that may give them difficulty as years go by. This system is intended to rationalize those pressure points and provide an objective view of how treatment can be applied or comfort achieved through specialty cushions. This is a service that is new to UHNBC and is expected to have immense applications for bettering health outcomes for patients right here at home in the North, where we live, work and play.
